
## TYPES AND WIDTHS OF CARPET TACK STRIP AVAILABLE



Tack strip less than one inch (standard width) is not recommended for stretch-in carpet installations.

Plywood tack strip widths do vary and the narrower widths cause additional problems for installers. Pre-nails and pins get closer to the wall as the width narrows.

It is recommended to use one inch wide (standard width) tack strip for all carpet installations less than 30 ft. long.

Pre-nails and front and back row of pins are moved farther from the wall for easier nail setting, extra strength and easier carpet hooking.

Aluminum carpet strip is recommended for ONE INCH OR carpet installations where water or termites STANDARD WIDTH may cause damage to plywood tack strips. **ALUMINUM** 

Will not rust, rot or be eaten by insects.

Its is recommended to use tack strip with 3 rows of pins and at least 1 1/4 inches wide for carpet installations over 30 ft. long.

Extra pins provide more strength. Wider plywood provides stronger platform for power stretching.
